Construction update

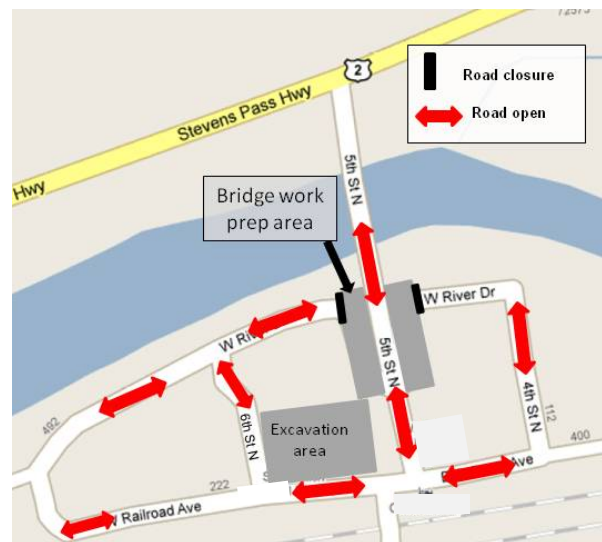

Recent activities

- Completed excavation and continued backfilling in the Northwest Developed Zone (NWDZ). Additional excavation in Town right-of-way near the Skykomish School is occurring today and tomorrow.
- Completed site preparation and demolition of restaurant portion of the Cascadia.
- Sheetpile installation at the east end of the hydraulic control and containment (HCC) is scheduled to be completed today. Backfilling and other activities will continue in the area this week. Railroad Avenue at this location will be reopened to two-way traffic soon.

What's happening next?

- Site preparation and overburden excavation for the 5th Street Bridge work will start next week. **Access to East River Road and West River Road from 5th Street N will be temporarily closed starting on June 14 for the duration of the bridge work** (see map). **The bridge is currently scheduled to be closed for 7 days to traffic and pedestrians beginning June 21.** Crews will be working long hours and on weekends to accomplish this work. More information will arrive in mailboxes and around town shortly.
- Crews will install a water bypass in preparation for the 5th Street Bridge work tomorrow, June 10. A temporary water outage will affect residents and businesses north of the Skykomish River between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Affected residents and businesses have been notified.
- Backfilling in the NWDZ is scheduled to be completed by the end of this week and Railroad Avenue by the NWDZ will be reopened to two-way traffic. 6th Street is scheduled to be re-opened by early next week.
- Crews are scheduled to move the Community Center, Town Maintenance Building, and Ward building back to their original locations on Railroad Avenue next week (6/14). Foundation work on these buildings will start the following week.
- Archaeology crews are completing their investigations at the Cascadia today. Crews are scheduled to install shoring and begin excavation by the end of this week. Excavation and backfill will continue throughout next week. **Railroad Avenue in front of the Cascadia will be reduced to one lane for the duration of this work.**
